Duration 1 Day

Objective

Primarily designed to enable employees who work on customer sites to be able to prove their basic knowledge of Health and Safety. Successful trainees are issued with a robust Passport photocard, which is tamper-proof, secure and easy to verify. The nationally recognised scheme reflects HSE guidance and is supported by numerous work sectors.

Course Content

Safety, Health, Environmental Law and You

Law – Legal systems, duty of care, negligence, Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations, authorisation, enforcement, inspectors and environmental protection.

Risk Assessment

An introduction to risk assessment and the hierarchy of control.

Workplace Safety

Access/egress, vehicles, emergencies, workplace safety, PUWER, Electricity, Machinery, DSE Regulations, housekeeping and safety signs.

Fire Precautions and Procedures

Fire prevention and control, extinguishers and Fire Precaution (Workplace) Regulations

Accident and First Aid Procedures

Accidents, RIDDOR, accident prevention, First Aid Regulations and duties.

Manual Handling

Employers and employees duties. Assessments, weight limits.

Substances Hazardous to Health

COSHH, hazardous substances and legal duties assessments.

Noise at Work

Noise regulations, action levels, duties and hearing protection.

Assessment

A multi choice assessment of 15 questions is performed after every two modules. All four assessments must be passed with a minimum 80% correct score per assessment.

Teaching & Learning Strategies

The teaching and learning strategies employed in this programme by the training consultants are based on the philosophy of experimental learning – “learning through doing”. Delegates are encouraged to participate as individuals and within groups.

A variety of methods are employed to deliver and enhance the learning experience. Trainer-led input is complemented by a variety of activities such as skills practice (role-play), practical exercises, discussions, presentations and case studies.

A strong emphasis is placed on the transfer of learning into the workplace. Delegates are encouraged and challenged to discover and identify ways they can each specifically apply the training experience to the workplace.
